



EMPTY CONTAINER ACCEPTANCE POLICY

RECYCLE TODAY FOR TOMORROW'S FUTURE

Qualifications for return:

- Safety Data Sheets (SDS) must be made immediately available to Enterprize Container Corp upon ECC's request for products previously contained in any container sent to ECC. Safety Data Sheets are required for all empty IBC's shipped to ECC for reconditioning and/or recycling that previously contained a hazardous product.
- Containers must be completely empty (**DRIP DRY**) before shipping to ECC's facility. If the valve or bung is opened and product can be poured out, the container is **NOT** completely empty.
- All caps and labels must be in place and valves must be closed. DOT 49 CFR § 173.29 states that all openings of the empty containers must be closed, and that all markings and labels must be in place as if the container was full of its original contents.
- An ECC Bill of Lading must accompany any shipment of containers sent to ECC. The ECC BOL must be signed at the time of shipment by a representative of the shipper's company.
- For residues or products specifically named in DOT 40 CFR §261.31, 261.32, or 261.33(e)¹ the container is empty **ONLY** if the container has been **TRIPLE RINSED** using a solvent capable of removing the last contained material, then drip dried as described above. 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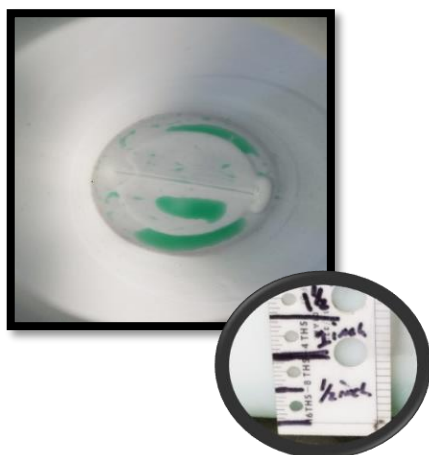
A container is **(COMPLETELY EMPTY)** when all free-flowing residues that cling to the interior surface of the container have been poured or scraped out, exposing 95% or more of the container's original surface.

Completely Drip Dried:

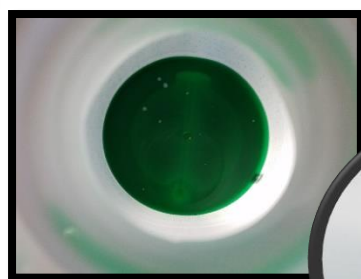
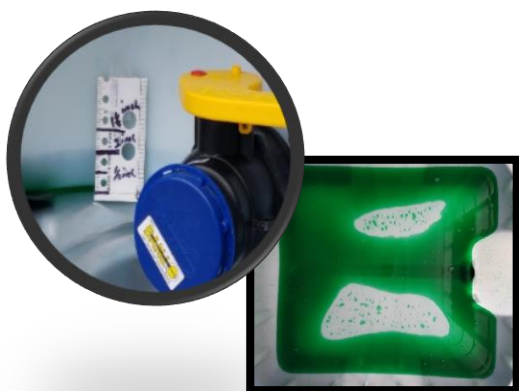

ECC Empty Container Acceptance Policy

- Containers NOT meeting ECC Empty Container Policy will be rejected and returned to the customer *at their expense* and will also incur a \$25 per container handling fee. The customer will be required to provide a BOL for return shipment via their carrier.

- ____ All containers have been prepared for shipment in accordance with EPA and DOT requirements as described in ECC Container Acceptance Policy.
- ____ Any container discovered to contain excessive residue which was shipped to us in error by the container generator must be immediately removed from our premises at the generator's expense.

By signature it is agreed that all containers shipped under the ECC Container Acceptance Policy will be in compliance with the above terms.
